
Rise of the Athenian Empire - Video 14

Delian League Key Events 478-461 BC

470s BC: Karystos (on the island Euboea) had resisted the Persians, but is now taken by Athens. Athens forces them into the Delian League, down their walls, and forces them to pay permanent every year OR ELSE.	Chalkis Eretria ea Marathon Megara Athens An Epidauros
471 BC: Naxos (island) decides it no longer wants to pay the Delian League dues, because it believes the war with Persia is over. It rebels, and Athens lays to the city, tears down the walls, disband the, and strips the Naxians of their vote in the Delian League, but forces them to still pay tribute.
