Nicias is not really the right man for the job. He is too conservative and cautious for such a risky campaign.

Nicias really wants to head, but he knows anything short of a victory will not be accepted in Athens. If he goes home empty-handed, he might end up like Alcibiades.
What to do? What to do? Follow his original plan and collect from Segesta, and try to settle the dispute between Segesta and Selinus.
He's only able to collect talents from Segesta. UGH – that's not going to work! The whole operation cost around talents. That's not enough to please Athens.
He also tries to follow Alcibiades' original plan: convince some of the Sicilian cities to join Athens in an UTTER FAILURE. Many of the towns believe Athens is there to all of Sicily, so they won't assist Athens. The devil you know (Syracuse) is better than the devil you don't (Athens).
All of this gave time to organize the defense of their city and plan for an attack.

(Too bad nobody used General Lamachus' original plan: use the element of surprise to just straight up attack Syracuse and force a quick surrender.) What makes a great general? Nicias only liked campaigns he knew he'd win. Bold campaigns need a bold leader. (In fairness this whole plan was not Nicias' idea!)
